ORDERS OF THE TRIBUNAL

THE TRIBUNAL, has found that a complaint made by the Director-General, Department of Local Government, that Councillor Sylvia Phyllis Hale, being a Councillor of Marrickville Council, contravened section 451 of the Local Government Act, 1993 in relation to consideration by the Council at its meeting held on 17 June 1997 of its Budget Resources Plan and Fees and Charges for 1997/1998 by failing to declare a pecuniary interest in that matter, taking part in the consideration or discussion of the matter, and voting on the matter, has been proved.

Pursuant to section 482(1) of the Act the Tribunal **ORDERS** that Councillor Hale be and she is hereby reprimanded for this contravention.

THE TRIBUNAL has also found that a complaint made by the Director-General, Department of Local Government, that Councillor Sylvia Phyllis Hale contravened section 449 of the Local Government Act, 1993 by failing to disclose certain interests in Returns required by that section to be lodged by Councillors in relation to the return date 15 September 1995 and the periods 1 July 1995 to 30 June 1996 and 1 July 1996 to 30 June 1997 has been proved.

Pursuant to section 482(1) of the Act, the Tribunal **ORDERS** that Councillor Hale be and she is hereby reprimanded for those contraventions.
