The Tribunal orders that Councillor John Frederick Miller of Orange City Council be and he is hereby severely reprimanded for his contravention of section 451 of the Local Government Act, 1993 by failing to disclose a pecuniary interest and by participating in the consideration and discussion and voting on the matter of a proposal to provide financial assistance to the Orange Chamber of Commerce & Industry for its "Shop Orange" campaign which was before the Council at its meetings on 7 and 21 November 1996.
