# FAQs on border closure now online

The NSW Government has released comprehensive FAQs on the temporary closure of the NSW-Victorian border.

The new Public Health Order relating to the border closure can be viewed here.

Anyone wishing to travel from Victoria to NSW now needs to apply for a COVID-19 NSW border declaration permit through this <u>Service NSW page</u>.

Special conditions are in place for freight operations and other critical services. Provisions are also in place for residents of declared border regions, such as Albury-Wodonga.

All questions about permits should be directed to Service NSW.
