The Local Government Pecuniary Interest and Disciplinary Tribunal, <u>HAVING FOUND</u> that a complaint made by the Director General, Department of Local Government, pursuant to s.460 of the *Local Government Act 1993* that against Councillor Ricardo D'Amico being a councillor of Lane Cove Municipal Council contravened Chapter 14, Part 2 of that Act in respect of the consideration by the Council at a meeting of 21 July 2004 of a proposal by Woolworths Ltd to build a retail development at Austin Street, Lane Cove has been proved.

Pursuant to s.482(1) of the Act, the Tribunal <u>ORDERS</u> that Councillor D'Amico be and he hereby is suspended from civic office for a period of 5 months commencing on 1 November 2006 and expiring on 31 March 2007.
