The Tribunal has found that a complaint made by the Director-General, Department of Local Government, pursuant to s.460 of the *Local Government Act 1993* that Councillor Carmel Del Duca, being a Councillor of the City of Canada Bay Council, contrary to Chapter 14 Part 2 of that Act, did not complete and lodge with the General Manager within three months after becoming such a Councillor a return in the form prescribed in Part 1 of Schedule 3, has been proved.

Pursuant to s.482(1) of the Act the Tribunal <u>ORDERS</u> that Councillor Del Duca be and she is hereby reprimanded.
